City of Greater Dandenong – Library Services

The Libraries are a key space for the community to access Council publications, community consultations, programs, events and information about local attractions.






Local not-for-profit and volunteer organisations can submit flyers or brochures to be displayed in the Community Information Stand. The display of material is subject to approval from Library Management.

The following will not be accepted for display:

- Material that promotes
  - Political and religious ideology
  - Businesses or commercial ventures
  - Conduct inconsistent with Federal, State or Local Council laws and regulations.
- Material that does not fit within the allocated display stand
- Posters.

Information in languages other English must be accompanied with accredited English translations.

Brochures and flyers can be submitted in person or mailed to the City of Greater Dandenong – Library Services, PO Box 200, Dandenong.
