## The City of Greater Dandenong is planning to make streetscape improvements to the Hemmings Street Shopping Centre

This project builds on the ideas that you may have provided at the previous community workshop held in 2013. The four areas that the community told us they would like to see improved were:

- ✓ **Attractiveness**  
- look and feel of the street
- ✓ **Social Cohesion**  
- provide ways to bring everyone together
- ✓ **Amenity**  
- improved parking, seating and lighting

Since receiving your feedback, Council has installed more trees, CCTV cameras and shopping centre signage. Council is now considering improvement of the street layout between Jones Road and Purdy Avenue.

# THE OPTIONS



Three concept options have been prepared and all the three options include:

- **New pavement** along the northern side of Hemmings Street between Jones Road and Purdy Avenue
- **A raised road pavement** at Wilma Avenue intersection to improve safety and amenity of the pedestrian crossing
- **New seating** and planting at Jones, Wilma, and Purdy Avenue corner
- **More trees** in the Council carpark
- **More seats** along kerbs for socialising

## SPECIFIC FEATURES

## STREET VIEW

### OPTION 1

- Existing carparks retained



### OPTION 2

- Kerb extension for new trees and grouped seats
- Minor loss of car parking (3 spaces)



### OPTION 3

- Kerb extension at cafes and takeaways for trees, seats and tables
- Loss of car parking (7 spaces)
