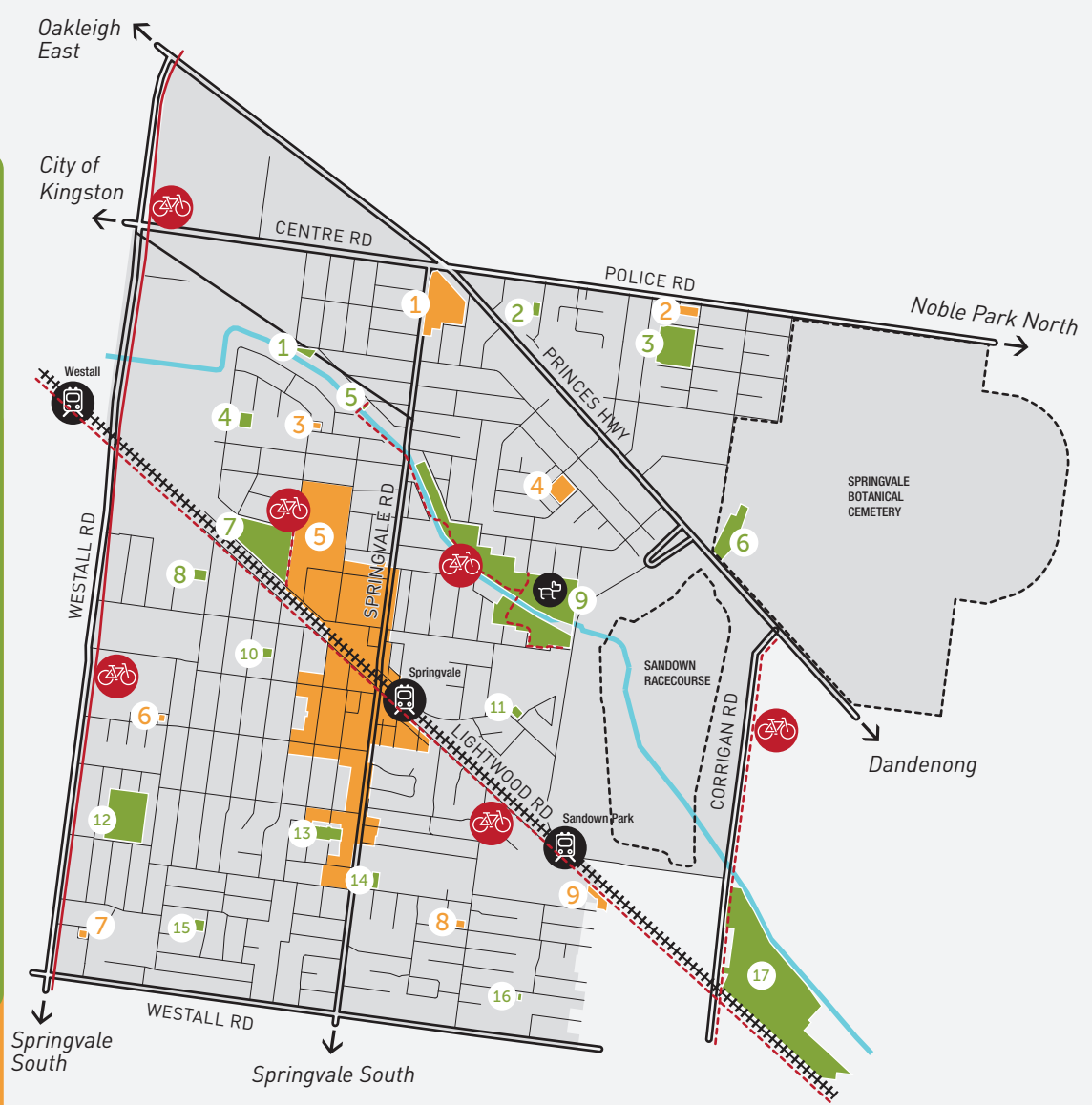

OPEN SPACE IN SPRINGVALE

Springvale contains 27 hectares of public open space, comprising 16 parks. Springvale contains a mix of passive parks, sports reserves and a dog off leash area. Warner Reserve is the largest of the four district parks, providing in addition to the sports fields and playground, a dog off leash area, walking and cycle trails along Mile Creek and an informal connection to Ross Reserve, Noble Park via Lightwood Road. The majority of the public parks and reserves are smaller neighbourhood and local parks within the large central residential area. These parks provide local playgrounds, grass areas to play, shaded areas to sit under trees and in some parks picnic and bbq facilities. The Springvale Botanical Cemetery, Sandown Racecourse and the Greyhound Course are the predominant use within the eastern section of the suburb.
