TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Drum Theatre acts as ticketing agent for the City of Greater Dandenong (Council), which provides the tours.
2. The provider (Council) reserves the right to vary advertised tour dates as necessary.
3. Tour commences promptly and leaves the dedicated meeting point so please ensure that you arrive 10 minutes prior to the commencement time as stated on your booking confirmation.
4. Tours with less than eight attendees may be unable to proceed as advertised. Customers will be advised of any cancellations at least 3 working days prior to the scheduled tour and offered the choice of an alternative tour date.
5. Information regarding the meeting point of the tour will be sent to participants on payment of ticket.
6. Tours proceed regardless of the weather. Please dress accordingly, with appropriate footwear.
7. Bookings will close 5 days prior to the scheduled tour date.
8. Participants join the tour at their own risk and indemnify Council against all loss, damage, expense or injury.
9. Food allergies/intolerances are to be disclosed at the time of booking.
